

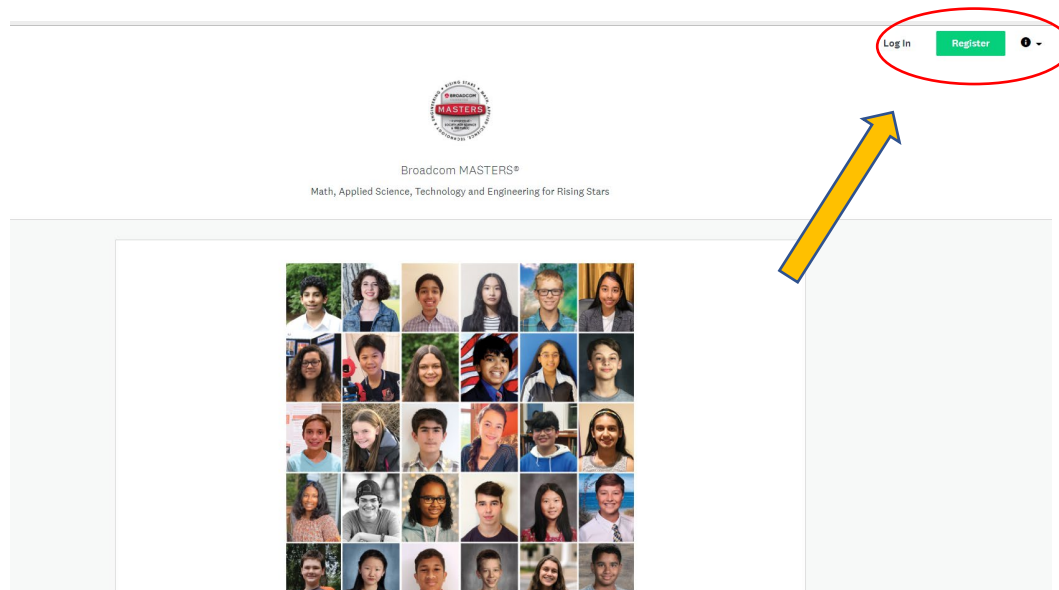


# Broadcom MASTERS 2021

## How to Open an Application

Congratulations on earning a nomination to Broadcom MASTERS! The top 10% of 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade competitors at Society-affiliated fairs in the US are eligible for nomination. Use this guide for step-by-step instructions on how to create an account and start your application today!

1. To open an application, first click the green “Register” button at <https://apply-broadcommasters.smapply.io/>



2. On the next page you will enter your Fair Password, given to you by your Fair Director. If you don't have your fair password, email [masters@societyforscience.org](mailto:masters@societyforscience.org) with your name, city, state, and name of the fair you competed in this year.

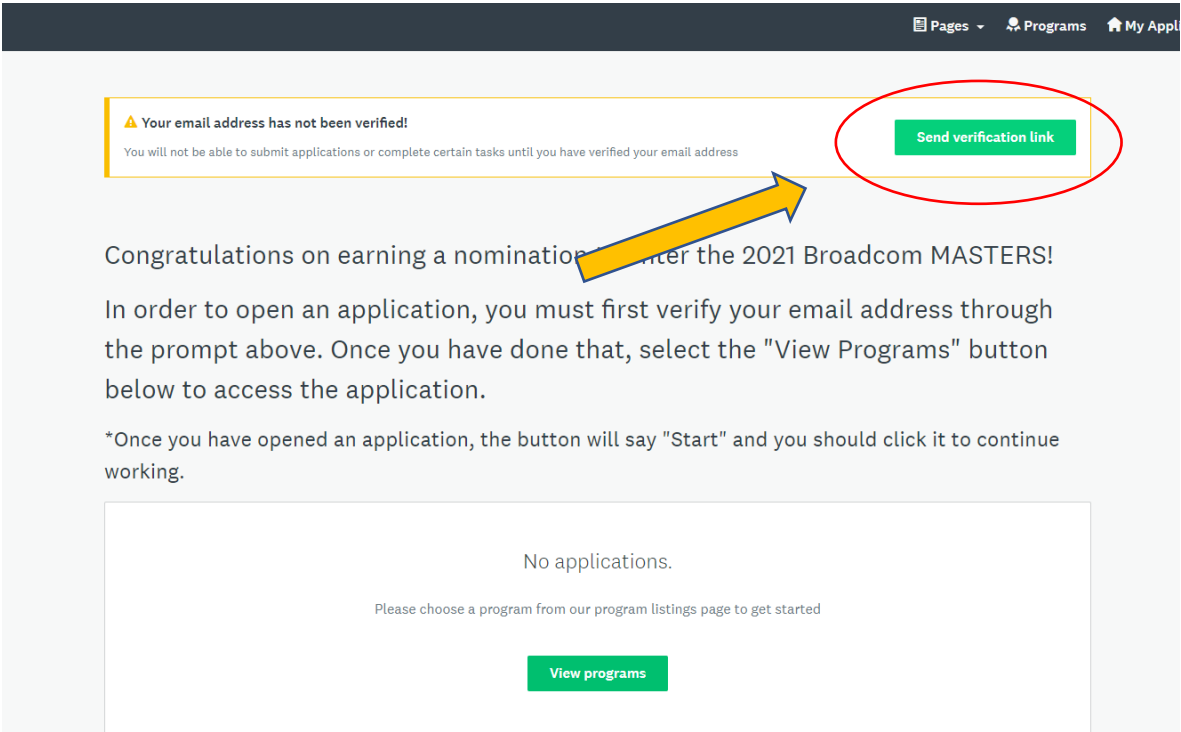

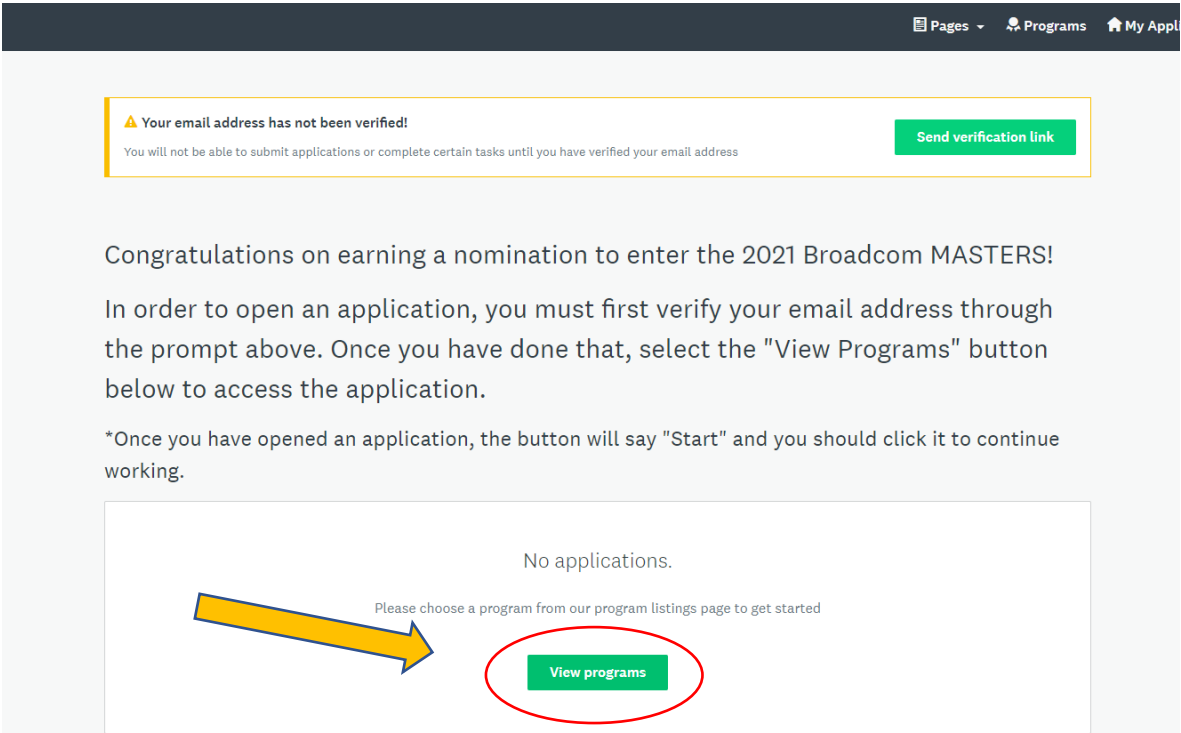

- Once you have created an application, you will need to verify your email address. If you do not automatically get it within a few minutes, click the green “Send verification link” button at the top of the next page.



- Once you have confirmed your email address, you will need to log back in and click on the “View programs” button.



5. Under programs, you will now have the option to begin the application for the Broadcom MASTERS 2021 by clicking “more.”

The Broadcom MASTERS is the only middle school STEM competition that leverages Society-affiliated science fairs as a crucial component of the STEM talent pipeline. As a Broadcom MASTERS Nominee, you are part of the top 10 percent of 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade projects entered into Society-affiliated fairs around the country - that's a huge accomplishment!

4. Upload your visual aid PDF (data, charts, graphs, etc.).
5. Upload your signed [Parent/Guardian Permission Form 2021](#).
6. Upload your science fair approval forms (if applicable).
7. Download your application to review your responses, [using the button in the upper right hand corner \(button will appear after you have completed Part 1\)](#).
8. Submit all information by [Wednesday, June 9, 2021, at 8:00pm Eastern Time](#). Be sure to hit the "Submit" button!
